The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) has reviewed your request dated September 24, 2005 and accepted October 6, 2005. This request was for an extension of approval to TC-84A-4230 to add the model F720C/V N95 filtering facepiece that is similar in design to the model F710C/V but incorporates plastic hangers for the head strap attachment method.
